A. NOTICE TO THE COURT AND PARTIES

1. The Applicant gives notice that he relies upon the Vienna Convention on Succession of States in respect of Treaties 1978, the Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties 1969, relevant customary international law, the Basic Law, and the instruments, pleadings and evidence filed or served in HCMP 1855 of 2022 and related proceedings.
2. The Applicant seeks directions concerning the procedural reception and determination of materials said to establish a succession of State, the continuation or devolution of treaty rights and obligations, the constitution of the parties, service, preservation of property and records, and consequential relief.
3. This filing is not presented as a substitute for any diplomatic act required under international law. It asks the Court to receive the materials, settle the procedural issues, identify the questions requiring determination, and give directions for further evidence, service and hearing.

B. RELIEF SOUGHT

1. The Court receive this Notice and the annexed Proposed Notification of Succession in respect of Treaties as materials relied upon in HCMP 1855 of 2022, subject to relevance, admissibility and further order.
2. The Applicant file, within such period as the Court directs, a verified schedule identifying: (a) the predecessor State; (b) the successor State; (c) the territory concerned; (d) the date and juridical event of succession; (e) each treaty said to continue, devolve or bind; (f) the depositary or competent authority; and (g) the evidence relied upon for each proposition.
3. The Applicant file affidavit evidence exhibiting the instruments, notices, filed proceedings, orders, correspondence, service records and other materials relied upon as establishing the succession, the authority to give notification, and the consequences said to arise in HCMP 1855 of 2022.
4. Any question of addition, removal or substitution of a party, or continuation of the proceeding by or against a person or body said to have succeeded to an interest, be determined under Order 15 of the Rules of the High Court.
5. The Applicant have leave, insofar as required, to apply under Order 20 to amend the title, descriptions of parties, capacities, grounds and relief after determination of the preliminary succession and party-constitution issues.
6. Any person or body whose legal status, treaty rights, property, obligations or procedural position may be directly affected file and serve a concise statement of position within the time directed by the Court.
7. Directions be given under Order 11 concerning service outside Hong Kong, including service upon foreign governmental bodies, officeholders, treaty depositaries, record-holders and other persons identified by the Court.

8. Directions be given under Order 29 for preservation of property, records, treaty instruments, communications, electronic data and other subject matter pending determination of the succession and treaty issues.
9. Directions be given under Order 24, subpoena procedure or such other process as the Court considers available for production of records held by parties and identified non-party record-holders.
10. The Court determine whether the issues raised should continue within HCMP 1855 of 2022, be heard together with HCAL 1179 of 2026, or be brought by separate originating process.
11. Pending further order, no person served with this Notice destroy, alter, conceal or dispose of records specifically relating to the alleged succession, treaty status, service, governmental notice, title, property, contractual commitments or the capacities pleaded in HCMP 1855 of 2022.
12. Such further or other orders be made as the Court considers just.

C. QUESTIONS FOR PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION

1. Whether the materials relied upon identify a succession of States within the meaning of applicable international law.
2. What State, territory and international relations are said to be affected, and on what date the alleged succession occurred.
3. Whether the 1978 Convention applies by treaty obligation, customary international law, analogy, or another identified source of law.
4. What provisions of the 1969 Convention are relied upon, including Articles 26, 27, 31 to 33, 46, 53, 64, 65 to 68 and 73, and what procedural or substantive consequences are said to follow.
5. Whether the Applicant possesses authority or full powers to communicate a notification on behalf of the State or successor State identified in the proposed notification.
6. Whether any notification has been transmitted to a treaty depositary, treaty parties, contracting States or another competent international authority, and what legal effect that transmission has.
7. Whether any interest in HCMP 1855 of 2022 has devolved so as to require joinder, substitution, amendment or representation under Order 15 or Order 20.
8. What service is required, upon whom, and through what lawful method.
9. What interim preservation orders are required to protect property, records and the effectiveness of the proceeding.
10. Whether and to what extent the issues are justiciable in the Court of First Instance and fall within HCMP 1855 of 2022.

D. HIGH COURT RULES PROCEDURAL BASIS

Order 32 - Interlocutory application and directions

1. The Applicant seeks relief within an existing proceeding. The immediate request is for directions, not a final determination without notice. The application is therefore brought by summons and supported by affidavit evidence.

Order 15 - Addition, substitution and devolution of interest

2. If the alleged succession has procedural consequences for the identity or capacity of a party, the Court is asked to determine addition, substitution, representation or continuation under Order 15.

Order 20 - Amendment

3. Any change to the title, party descriptions, pleaded capacities, grounds or relief should occur only by leave or direction of the Court.

Order 29 - Preservation and interlocutory relief

4. The Applicant seeks preservation of property and records so that the subject matter of the proceeding and the evidence relevant to succession and treaty status are not altered before determination.

Order 53 - Public-law consequences

5. To the extent a Hong Kong public authority has failed or refused to consider, preserve, transmit, refer or determine materials said to engage treaty obligations or public powers, the Applicant relies upon the related judicial-review proceeding and seeks coordinated case management.

E. INTERNATIONAL-LAW MATERIALS RELIED UPON

1. The Vienna Convention on Succession of States in respect of Treaties 1978 is relied upon for its definitions, principles and notification framework, including the requirement to identify the succession, the relevant treaties and the authority by which a notification is made.
2. The Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties 1969 is relied upon for the principles that treaties in force are to be performed in good faith, internal law is not ordinarily a justification for failure to perform, treaties are interpreted in good faith in accordance with their ordinary meaning, context and object and purpose, and succession of States is not prejudged by that Convention.
3. The Applicant also relies upon customary international law and the principles of the Charter of the United Nations to the extent pleaded and proved.
4. The Applicant acknowledges that the legal effect of each instrument depends upon treaty participation, territorial application, constitutional allocation of foreign-affairs authority, customary law, proof and the Court's jurisdiction.

F. FACTUAL AND PROCEDURAL FOUNDATION

1. HCMP 1855 of 2022 was commenced as miscellaneous proceedings concerning the Crown, the Attorney General, and the capacities of Liquidator and Managing Controller identified in the originating materials.
2. The Applicant relies upon earlier proceedings filed in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado during January and March 2022, subsequent Hong Kong proceedings, notices of service, filed instruments, correspondence and related materials as part of the chain by which jurisdiction, capacities, succession, treaty obligations and enforcement are said to have been notified and preserved.
3. The Applicant relies upon the Notice of Intention to Proceed under Order 3, rule 6, the proposed representative-proceeding materials, the record-production submissions and the Form 86 materials in HCAL 1179 of 2026 as identifying the broader procedural and evidentiary matrix.

4. The Applicant says the proposed notification is relevant to the identity and capacity of parties, the preservation and control of property, the continuation of treaty obligations, the effect of governmental acts and the remedies sought in HCMP 1855 of 2022.

G. LIMITS OF THIS APPLICATION

1. This application does not ask the Registry to perform the role of a treaty depositary or foreign ministry.
2. This application does not ask the Court to determine the rights of an absent State or person without service and procedural fairness.
3. This application does not ask for a final criminal finding, confiscation order or monetary judgment without the procedure and jurisdiction required by law.
4. The immediate purpose is to secure directions, preserve the subject matter, define the legal and factual questions, and provide a lawful path to determination.

H. PROPOSED FORM OF SHORT ORDER

1. The issue whether the Applicant may rely upon the proposed notification and international-law materials in HCMP 1855 of 2022 be set down for a directions hearing.
2. Within 21 days, or such other period as the Court directs, the Applicant file and serve: (a) a verified succession schedule; (b) an affidavit exhibiting the primary instruments and service evidence; (c) a concise statement of the legal effect contended for; and (d) proposed amended parties and relief, if any.
3. Any affected person served with the materials may file a concise response limited to authority, authenticity, treaty status, jurisdiction, service, party constitution and interim preservation.
4. No final determination of State succession, treaty liability, title, vesting, party substitution or substantive liability be made before further order.
5. All relevant records be preserved pending the directions hearing.
6. Liberty to apply.

I. PROPOSED NOTIFICATION OF SUCCESSION IN RESPECT OF TREATIES

This proposed instrument is annexed for evidentiary and directions purposes. It should be completed only after the predecessor State, successor State, territory, date of succession, authority and treaty schedule have been verified.

NOTICE IS GIVEN, subject to the directions and determination of the High Court of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and without prejudice to any diplomatic or depositary requirement, that the State identified above is said to have succeeded to the international responsibility for the territory identified above on the stated date. The proposed successor State gives notice of the position contended for in relation to each treaty in the Treaty Schedule. This instrument is communicated for preservation, notice, evidentiary and procedural purposes and is to be read with the affidavit and primary instruments filed in HCMP 1855 of 2022.

J. SERVICE AND NOTICE

1. This Notice and Summons should be served only in the manner directed or permitted by the Court and applicable law.
2. The proposed recipients include the parties to HCMP 1855 of 2022, the parties to HCAL 1179 of 2026 whose interests are directly affected, and any additional person or body identified by the Court for notice, joinder or production purposes.

3. Where a recipient is outside Hong Kong, the Applicant seeks directions under Order 11 and does not rely solely upon ordinary email transmission as constituting formal service of originating or interlocutory process.
